Welcome to the largest State Championship Tournament in the history of Ohio Youth Basketball. Over 240 total teams are competing.

With the large number of entries in this years tournament, we must conduct Sunday's Championship Tournament in the 3 D Format for the Grade Divisions with 24 or more teams, which include the Boys 6th thru 10/11th grades.

Listed below is how Sunday's Championships will be determined in those divisions

D 1 - All 1st Place Pool Winners play in a Single Elimination Tournament against other 1st Place Pool Winners

D 2 - All 2nd Place Pool Finishers play in a Single Elimination Tournament against other 2nd Place Pool Finishers

D 3 - All 3rd Place Pool Finishers play in a Single Elimination Tournament against other 3rd Place Pool Finishers

Individual awards are given to the 1st and 2nd place teams in all three tournaments Divisions.

Team trophies will be given to the D 1 Champion and Runner Up along with the individual awards. The D 1 3rd Place teams will also receive team trophies.

The Boys 3rd thru 5th Grade and the Girls 4th thru 10/11th Grade divisions will be conducted as usual.

This is as much about safety as it is anything. We could not in good conscious have the players in the Championship games playing their 5th game of the day.

BEHAVIOR

If an official deems that a player is trying to engage another player into a physical altercation, that player will be disqualified. If a player throws a punch, even without connecting, not only will that player be disqualified from the tournament, but the entire team will be disqualified from the tournament and fees will not be refunded. Fighting in Ohio Youth Basketball events will not be tolerated.

Only Two players from the same Jr High (7th & 8th) can play together and only two players from the same High School (9th-10th-11th) can play together during out of season competition. Tie Breaking Procedure

5 Team Pools Only

1. When two teams are tied and they played each other, we determine the higher seed by their head to head result.

2. When two teams are tied and they have not played each other, we use the following to decide the higher seed.

A. The best record of the opponents.

Example

Team 2 and 3 are tied at with a record of 1 - 1

Team 2 opponents have a combined record of 3 - 1

Team 3 opponents have a combined record of 1 - 3

Team 2 is the higher seed. If teams are still tied then go to B

B. The highest + - score

Example

Team 2 won by 3 and lost by 6 which = -3

Team 3 won by 12 and lost 10 which = +2

Team 2 is the higher seed. If teams are still tied then go to C

C. The highest + - score of the opponents

Example

Team 2's opponents were a combined +8

Team 3's opponents were a combined + 6

Team 3 is the higher seed. If teams are still tied flip a coin.

3. When three teams are tied use the same procedure as in No. 2 even if two of the teams have played each other. Any questions call OYB at 740-808-0380

Tie Breaking Procedure

The higher seeded team when two teams have the same record after completion of pool play will be determined by the winner of their head to head competition.

To determine the seeding when three teams have the same record after completion of pool play we must use the plus/minus formula. **Only games involving those teams ties will be used.**

Please see below for an example:

Team # 1	Won 2 Lost 1	Beat #2 by 4 pts.	Lost to #3 by 8 pts	Beat #4 by 18 pts
Team # 2	Won 2 Lost 1	Lost to #1 by 4 pts.	Beat #3 by 16 pts	Beat #4 by 20 pts

1st - Team # 1 has totals of +4 and -8 = -4

2nd - Team # 2 has totals of -4 and +15 = +11

3rd - Team # 3 has totals of +8 and -15 = -7

Team # 3 is 3rd because they have the lowest + - score

We now have two teams tied and go back to head to head results

Team # 1 is 1st because they beat Team # 2 head to head
